



DOE CASOLON is a fully sanded 20mm straight pile polypropylene grass tennis carpet installed exclusively by Doe in the UK since the early 1980s. It is exceptionally durable and, with simple routine care, can be maintained in good playing condition through many years of intensive use.



PERFORMANCE

With its 'best value' characteristics, **DOE CASOLON** is a good choice for schools and clubs as well as an excellent surface for private tennis courts. **CASOLON 20** may be used as a 'Multi-use' surface and there is a longer pile version of this carpet available specifically for Multi-use facilities where tennis is not the predominant sport. **CASOLON** offers a faster game for tennis than short pile carpets and so is favoured by players who enjoy the quicker pace of natural grass court play.

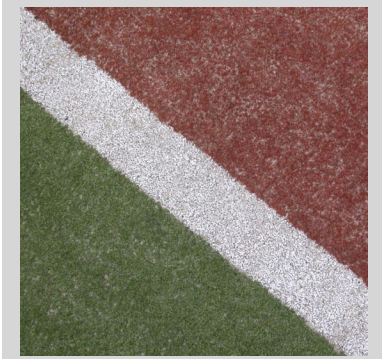
CASOLON is laid on a pervious asphalt (macadam) base over a free draining stone foundation such as our **DOE VICEROY** or **VISCOUNT** courts. Optimum playing characteristics are achieved some 2-3 months after installation and continue to improve during the first year.

Fashion can play a part in clients' choice of tennis surface. The 20mm long pile **CASOLON** was the most popular tennis 'grass' throughout the 1980s/early 1990s until the development of shorter pile tennis carpets in the mid 1990s. Our shorter pile carpets – **OLYMPUS** and **TROJAN** – then became the preferred choice. **CASOLON** is now seeing increasing demand, particularly in the North of England, Scotland and other wetter areas of the UK where its excellent drainage ensures minimum downtime.

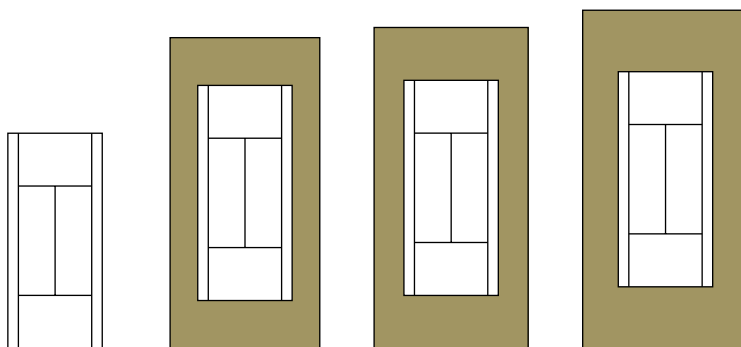
In common with all types of tennis carpet, **CASOLON** requires regular, routine maintenance to retain its good playing characteristics and prevent premature pile deflection and compaction. This is not onerous provided it is carried out regularly from the start and it will safeguard your investment.
